AUDIOLOGIST *Have the ear for medicine* – Evaluates auditory capacities for people with hearing problems and researches the factors and causes. \$ 23, 43 /h - 43, 25 /h

CLINICAL NURSE *A needs overview* – The clinical nurse is responsible for a variety of nursing care services according to biopsychosocial needs or groups of people whom they are entrusted with. \$ 24, 27 /h - 43, 25 /h

ORTHOPTIST *Eye rehabilitation* - Using special tests, orthoptists help diagnose vision disorders and apply non-surgical methods and treatment plans. \$ 22, 39 /h - 36, 07 /h

KINESIOLOGIST *The specialist in physical activity* – The kinesiologist uses movement for the purpose of prevention, treatment and performance. \$ 22, 38 /h - 41, 20 /h

MIDWIFE *Support in every moment* – Centralized on the needs of the pregnant woman, the midwife provides full care during pregnancy, childbirth and the postnatal period. \$ 29, 71 /h - 50, 41 /h

PHARMACIST *A good dose of knowledge* – Prepares medication based on physician's ordinance, updates patient records and provides information on medication. \$ 41, 23 /h - 52, 07 /h

PSYCHOLOGIST *Always listening* – Through various methods and intervention tools, they help people resolve their personal problems and adapt to different changes in their lives. \$ 25, 14 /h - 47, 67 /h



SPECIALIZED NURSE PRACTITIONER *The specialist in complex cases* – Works with the doctor to discover complex health problems and prioritize their care and treatment. \$ 29, 41 /h - 52, 44 /h



BIOMEDICAL ENGINEER *Making sure everything works!* – Assures that medical equipment is functional, stable and efficient. \$ 22, 76 /h - 43, 14 /h

CLINICAL PERFUSIONIST *Working the beat* - Clinical perfusionists use a heart-lung bypass machine during cardiac surgery to manage a patient's circulatory and respiratory functions. \$ 23, 95 /h - 45, 41 /h

MEDICAL PHYSICIAN *From theory to practice* – The medical physician uses the principles of physics in various fields including radiation oncology, diagnostic radiology, nuclear medicine and radiation protection. \$ 35, 96 /h - 49, 80 /h

NUTRITIONIST - DIETICIAN *An essential element in a healthy diet* – Assesses nutritional status of the individual and develops educational programs based on the individual. \$ 22, 74 /h - 41, 88 /h

PHYSIOTHERAPIST *To put you back on your feet* – Evaluates trouble, plan rehabilitation, applies treatment; there is no physical incapacity that a physiotherapist can't fix. \$ 25, 49 /h - 45, 42 /h

CLINICAL BIOCHEMIST *The lab pro* – Using analysis of biological liquids, the clinical biochemist determines a diagnosis and follows the evolution of a disease, as well as the effectiveness of a treatment. \$ 38, 62 /h - 50, 08 /h

GENERAL PRACTITIONER *All facets of the profession* – The general practitioner diagnoses and treats diseases, physiological disorders and injuries of the human body. \$ 95, 12 /h - 95, 12 /h

MEDICAL SPECIALIST *Several specialties, one objective* – According to his/her specialization, the medical specialist prevents and cures illnesses. He/she works in one of 54 specialties recognized in specialized medicine. \$ 123, 00 /h - 123, 00 /h

BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN *The machine specialist* – The biomedical engineering technician ensures the installation, calibration and proper operation of the biomedical electronic equipment. \$ 20, 02 / h - 28, 02 / h

MEDICAL ELECTROPHYSIOLOGY TECHNICIAN *Handle with care* – The medical electrophysiology technician performs medical examinations using precise electronic devices used to capture and record cardiac or brain activity. \$ 22, 49 / h - 30, 75 / h



ORTHOTIC AND PROSTHETIC TECHNICIAN *A giant step for rehabilitation!* – Creating, adjusting, repairing and modifying orthotics and prosthetics to help people walk, hear and see. \$ 20, 47 / h - 28, 02 / h

RECREATION TECHNICIAN *Action on the program* – Both creative and unifying, the recreation technician plans, organizes and animates social, cultural and sports programs. \$ 20, 76 / h - 29, 05 / h
